

The police asked us if anything else was missing. We checked to see if our money and jewellery were gone. Fortunately everything was in its place. It was just the food he was after. We asked our neighbors if they had heard or seen but nobody had. The police confirmed the identification of the man by matching his fingerprints with some that had been left on food containers from his previous burglaries. After the burglar confessed, the police asked him why he had committed those crimes. He said that he was a homeless man who was simply hungry and preferred eating home cooked meals to stealing from the supermarkets . he also said that he never stole anything apart from food. He was charged with burglary and can face up to two years in prison.




