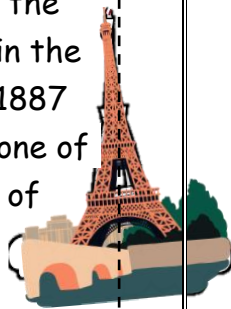

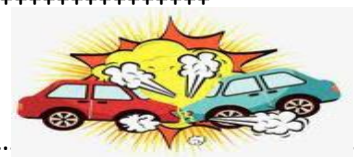

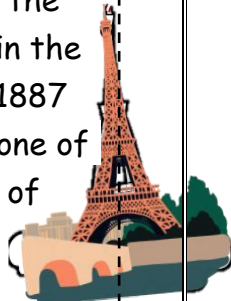

Titanic

The RMS Titanic was a cruise ship that sank in the North Atlantic Ocean on April 15, 1912. It is one of the deadliest ship disasters in history.

For its first trip, the Titanic was to sail from Southampton, England to New York City, USA. At the time it was the largest ship ever built. The ship even had watertight compartments for safety. Many thought Titanic was unsinkable. The ship left Southampton on April 10, 1912. There were 2,433 people onboard.

On April 14, the Titanic hit an iceberg. Over the next two and a half hours, the ship filled with water and sank. There were not enough lifeboats for everyone. Some people were able to get into lifeboats, but many were not. Those in the water died within minutes because the water temperature was 28 degrees. There were 710 survivor and over 1,500 who lost their lives. The loss of the Titanic shocked the world.

Titanic wasn't seen again until September 1, 1985, when a team found where it was in the ocean. It sits over 2 and a half miles deep on the ocean floor.

Today ships are much safer because of what was learned from Titanic. Titanic's story lives on through books, movies, memorials, and museums.

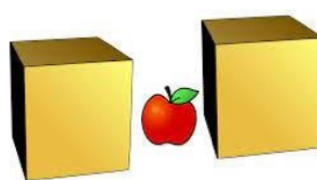
